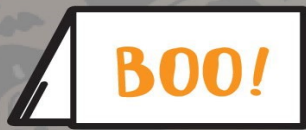
SAMHAINOPHOBIA

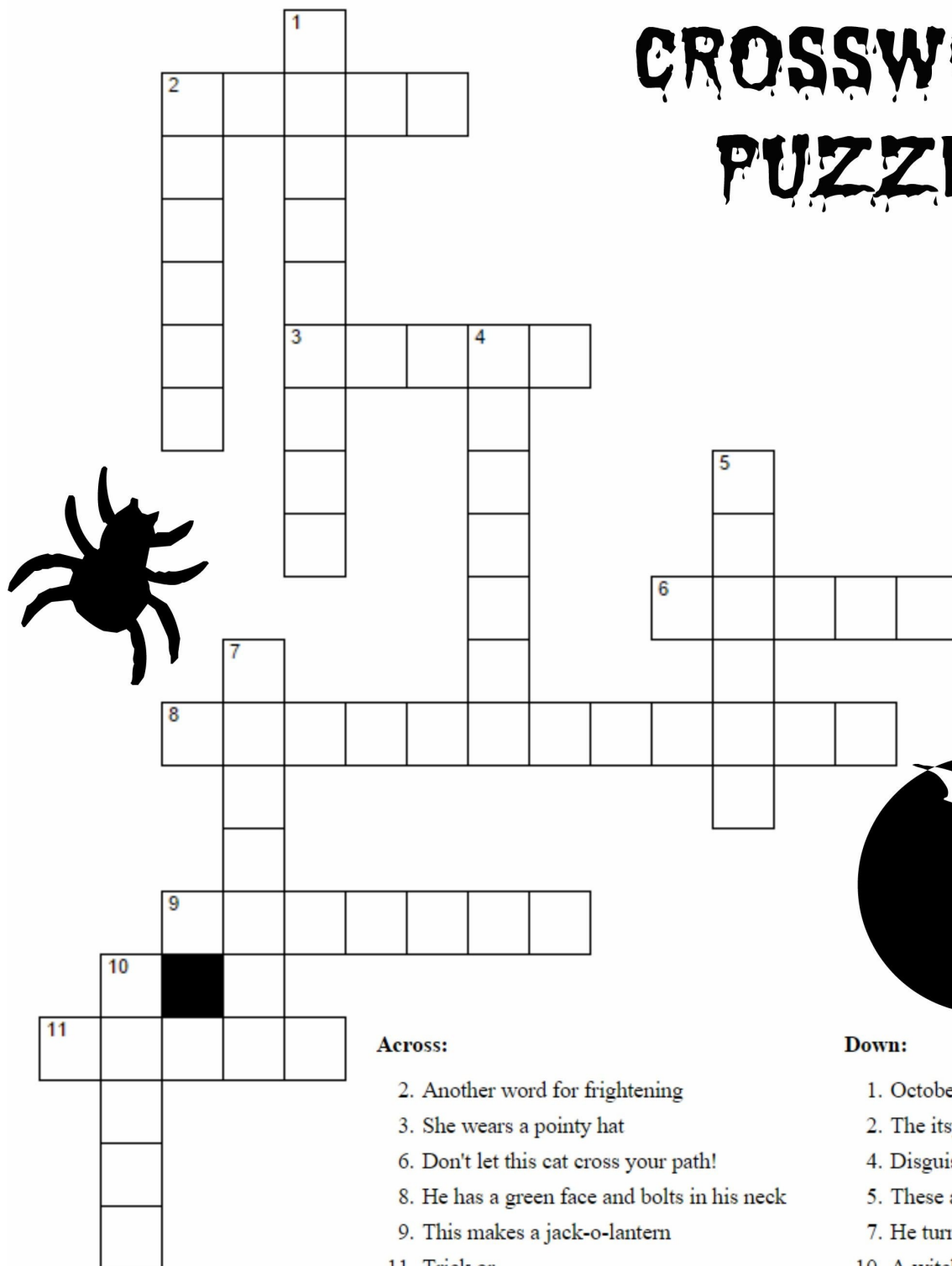
